

# Halloween Book Covers

Transform ordinary books into Halloween-themed novels and memoirs for easy, one-of-a-kind décor. Display on your coffee table or bookshelf to wow your family and friends with these wickedly witty titles!

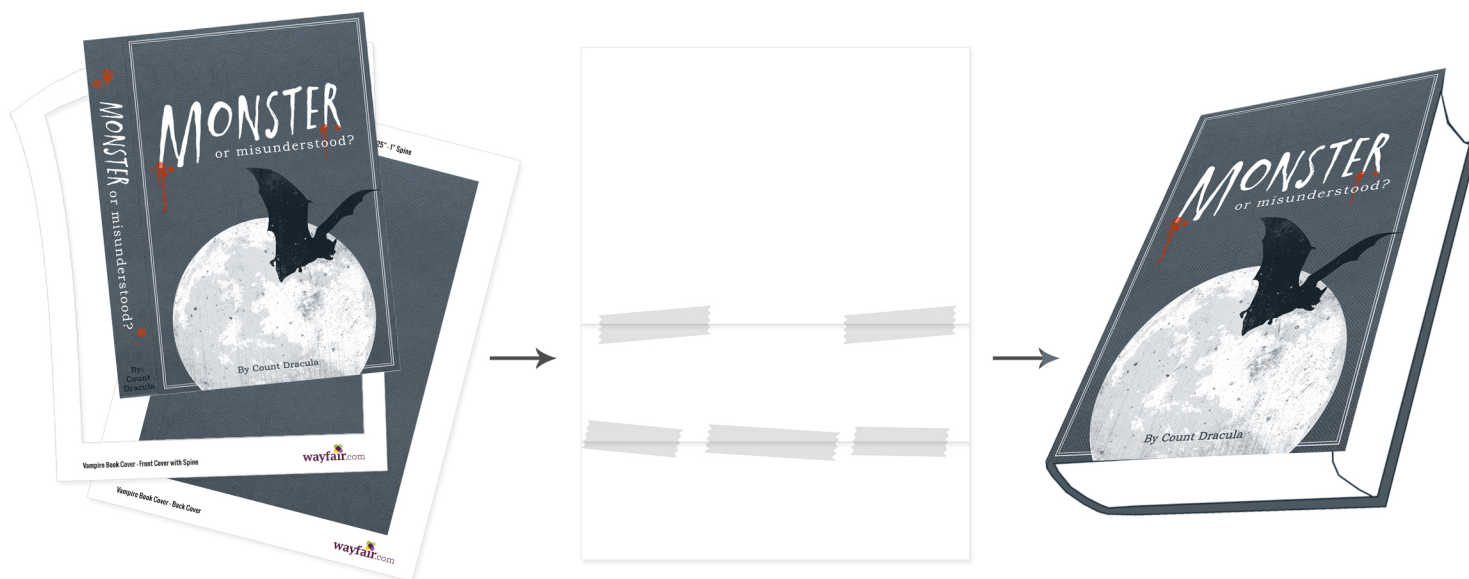
## You Will Need:

- 1 book, hard or soft cover, that measures 6.25" x 9.25"
- 3 sheets of white, 8.5" x 11" paper per book
- Something to cut with (scissors or an Xacto knife)
- Scotch tape

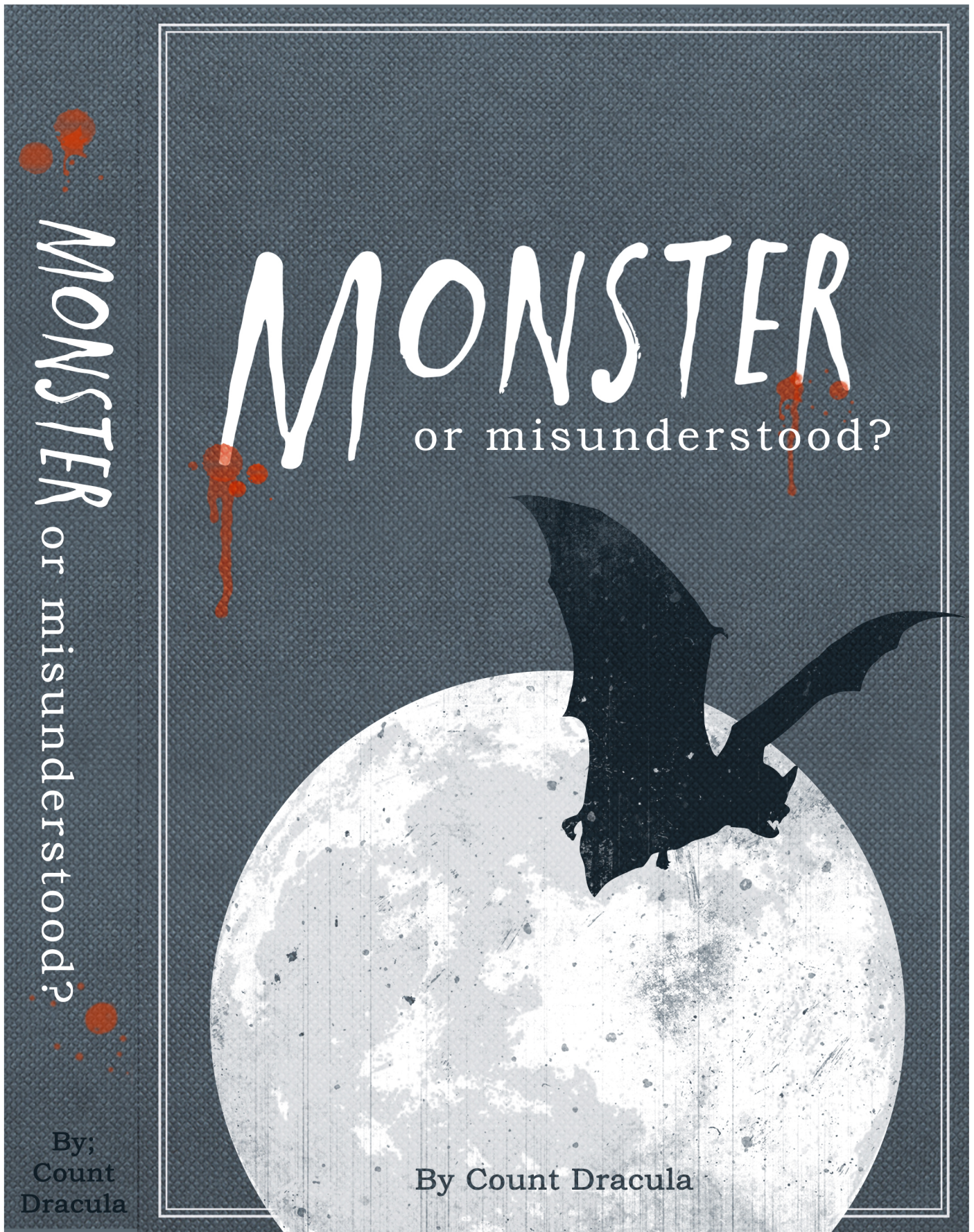


## Instructions:

1. Print all 3 parts of the book cover (front cover and spine, inside flaps, and back cover)
2. Cut each piece out with scissors or an Xacto knife. You will have four separate pieces: front, back, and two spines.
3. Tape the pieces together from the underside.  
\*TIP: Reinforce the seam by placing two smaller pieces of tape at the top and bottom of the long vertical piece.
4. Wrap the cover around a book of the appropriate size.
5. POOF! You've transfigured an ordinary book into a magically festive decoration!



Book Measurements: 6.25" x 9.25" - 1" Spine

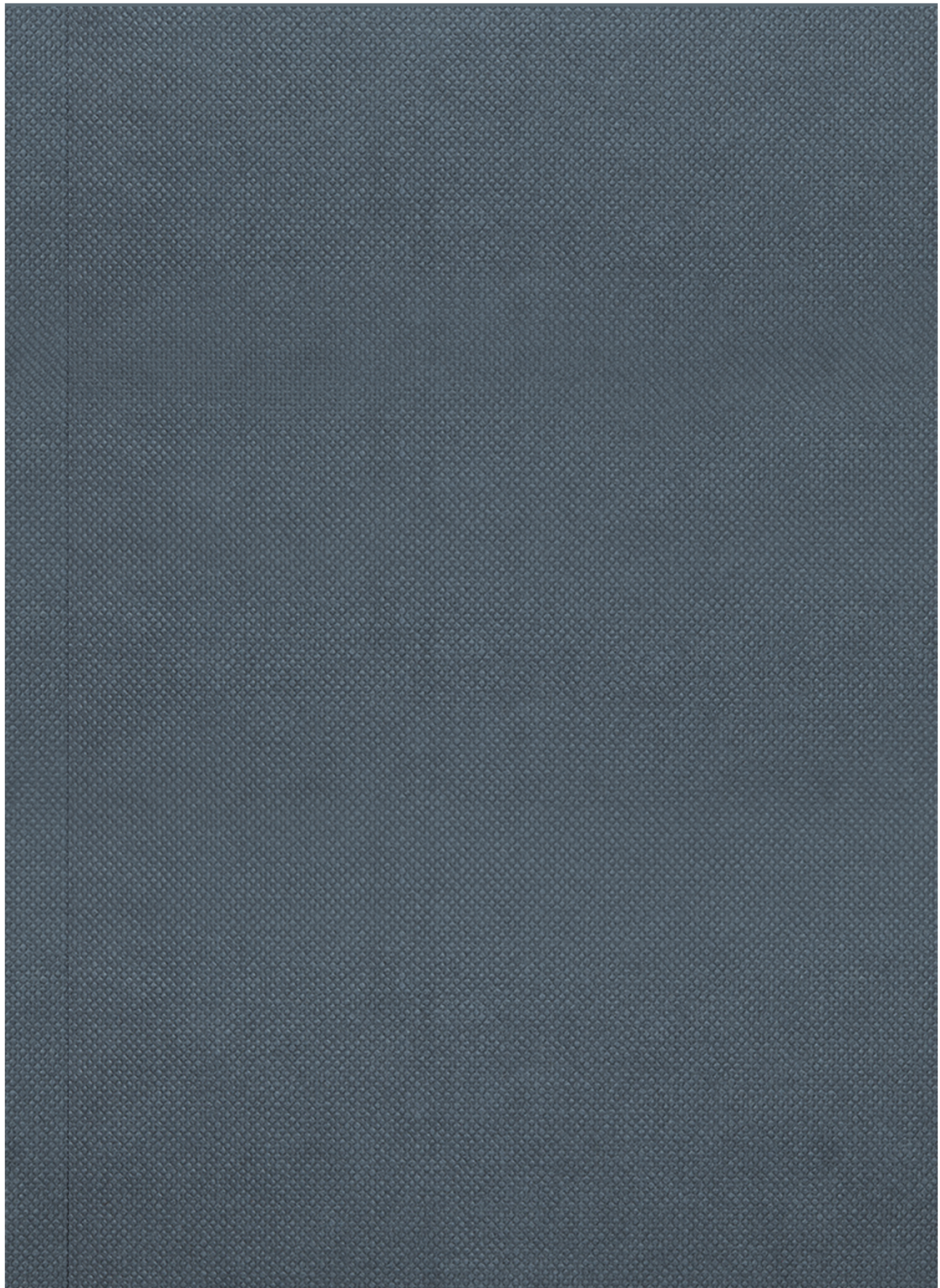
